Dates: 3rd and 4th December 2022 at Theewater Sports Club, Villiersdorp
18th and 19th February 2023 at Hermanus Yacht Club, Hermanus

Organising Authority: Theewater Sports Club under the auspices of SA Sailing.

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules Of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY 2.1 The regatta is open to all dinghy classes and Hobie class boats.

2.2 A minimum of five valid entries and finishers in any one race is required for class results. Classes with less than five entries will sail in an "O" class on a Portsmouth Rating basis.

2.3 Eligible boats may enter here <https://www.quicket.co.za/events/198200-tsc-classic-3-4-december-22>. Normal entries for Classic events will close the Monday before the event at midnight. After that Late entries apply.

2.4 Single handed entries will cost R350 (+R5 for Quicket) for normal entries and R450 (+R5 for Quicket) for late entries.

2.5 All competitors shall be members in good standing of SAS and of a yacht club affiliated to and in good standing with SAS (or their equivalent in the case of non-South Africans) and legally permitted to compete.

2.6 Proof of such membership shall be presented for registration.

Double handed entries will cost R600 (+R5 for Quicket) for normal entries and R700 (+R5 for Quicket) for late entries. All entry fees shall be paid prior to the close of registration. Failure to meet this requirement will result in the affected yacht being recorded as Did Not Compete until such time as the fee is paid. This changes rule A11.

Late entries will be accepted at the venue up to 2 hours prior to the start of the first race.

3 ADVERTISING 3.1 Advertising is permitted in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20.

3.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority in accordance with Regulation 20.

4 SCHEDULE 4.1 Registration: From 08:00 to 10:30 on the first day of the event.

4.2 Dates of racing:

Theewater Sports Club:

Saturday 3rd December 2022 First warning signal 11:30

Sunday 4th December 2022 First warning signal 10:00

Hermanus Yacht Club:

Saturday 18th February 2023 First warning signal 11:30

Sunday 19th February 2023 First warning signal 10:00

4.3 A maximum of 8 races are scheduled for each event.

4.4 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 14:00.

5 MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on the regatta website www.capeclassicseries.co.za and on the regatta whatsapp group no later than 10:00 on the Saturday of the regatta and will be available at registration.

7 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with a white flag

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

Classes with 5 – 9 entries 1st place

Classes with 10 – 14 entries 1st and 2nd place

Classes with 15+ entries 1st, 2nd and 3rd place

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of R 2 500 000.00 per incident or the equivalent.
